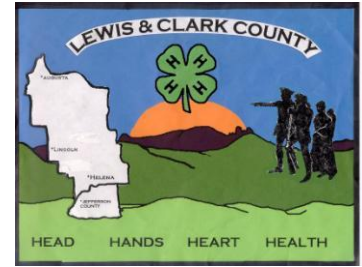




Adult 4-H Recognition Awards



Community Benefactor Award: Given to individual, club or business providing some special service to the Council.

Many Hats Award: Recognizes the volunteer who does it all! Regardless of any other award for which a volunteer may be eligible, this award recognizes the volunteer who is “always there.” Candidate must be a currently active, enrolled adult member.

Outstanding New Volunteer Award: This award is designated for volunteers who have been enrolled for five years or less, as an adult leader.

Appreciation Award: recognizes dedication and devoted service given to 4-H. Can be awarded to any active enrolled leader, volunteer or employed staff, whose service is outstanding.

Distinguished Service Award: Honors that individual who has already received the appreciation award and has continued to contribute significantly to 4-H countywide.
