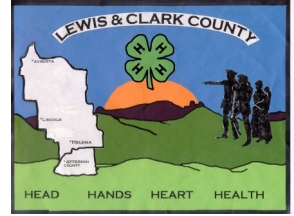


Junior Superintendent Application

Qualifications:

- Complete application and summary and return to Extension Office **by October 31st**
- For Outdoor projects, applicants must be 13-18 years old and for Indoor projects, applicants must be 11-18 years old (by October 1).
- Be a currently enrolled 4-H member in that project area (if applicable).
- Be able to commit to the responsibilities below.
- Must reapply as a Junior Superintendent each year.
- Can only be a Junior Superintendent for one Outdoor and one Indoor project each year and must be able to commit to the responsibilities of BOTH if applying in both areas.



*It is recommended that Junior Superintendents also complete the Leadership project.

Junior Superintendent is an important role for the Superintendents, therefore, Superintendent can appoint one as needed for remaining open positions after the deadline . Application still required.

Responsibilities:

- Work in partnership with the adult Superintendent in educational program planning, organization of Fair activities, weighing and tagging of animals (if applicable).
- Be willing to assist with educational workshops which may include helping organize the workshop, promotion, conducting demonstrations, etc.
- Be available at Fair to assist young or new 4-H members, be a positive role model, assist the superintendent during shows, interview judging or setup exhibit area, help weigh-in animals (if applicable), and practice good public relations and sportsmanship.
- ALWAYS exercise good herdsmanship and quality assurance practices for all animals (if applicable).
- Attend and participate in Indoor or Outdoor Committee meetings when available.
- Complete record and project books by the end of the 4-H year. Be available to assist other members with them as needed. Complete a 4-H Project Plan if there is no project book in your area.
- Responsibilities may vary slightly depending on project or content area and Superintendent.
